Understanding Community Care Law for Disabled Children

Course Aims

This course is intended to help people (with no prior knowledge) understand the Core Assessment process for identifying the care needs of disabled children.

This course is aimed at delegates whose role involves working with or caring for children with all types of disabilities. How social services departments assess children in need will be explained from a practical perspective; no prior knowledge will be assumed. The course will also consider the provision of Direct Payments and also what remedies may be available where someone is unhappy with the outcome of the assessment.

By the end of the course, the delegates will:-

- be able to explain how the Core Assessment process is carried out;
- understand how service provision decisions are made;
- know about the availability of Direct Payments to deliver services;
- know what remedies are available for those people who wish to challenge the decision of the local authority.
